To Whom It May Concern:

Thank you for your letter dated Oct 22, 2018 a copy of which is enclosed as well as completed forms you asked me to complete and return to you by Nov 21, 2018

In accordance with your letter, as stated on Page 8, I have checked the option:

I do not agree with some or all of the changes.

- 1) I am not refusing to pay taxes.
- 2) Provide me the *firsthand* evidence you have that I performed a taxable activity for 2016 (A 1099 is an information return, not evidence, *nor is any repeated bad payer data from the same third party*).
- 3) I do not give you my consent to change my tax return.

I filed my original 2016 return and included an affidavit reporting the *corrected* information along with an explanation for the changes with my jurat. (*First hand testimony*) I am enclosing a copy of this affidavit for your convenience.

No further action is required by the IRS other than to correct its information as I have reported it under penalty of perjury and correct its records based on the documents I have enclosed and respond to me that this matter is now closed.

- If you have allowable costs or expenses related to the unreported income that will change our proposal, it may benefit you to include the applicable form or schedule with your response.
