ORDER DENYING MOTION TO ADJOURN TRIAL

The Court considered the arguments of the Defendant in her motion for continuance, as well as the arguments of the Government in opposition. The Court cannot disagree with any of the reasons the Government has for opposing the motion. The current trial date was agreed to by the parties after the Court granted Plaintiff's request to adjourn an earlier trial date; the issues are not complex, and Plaintiff believes she can sufficiently represent herself with the assistance of standby counsel; and, the discovery produced by the Government has largely to do with Defendant's civil case that generated the Court Order that Defendant is charged with violating. See, *United States of America v Peter and Doreen Hendrickson*, 06-11753.

For these reasons, Defendants motion is **DENIED**.
