## What you need to do immediately

### If you agree with the amount and you're not working with an IRS representative

- Pay the amount due of \$147,334.65 by May 30, 2016, to prevent interest from continuing to increase.

Send us a check or money order with the payment stub or use one of the other payment options in this notice.

If we notified you that we suspended collection on your account due to financial hardship and you are still unable to make payments, you don't need to do anything.

### If you disagree with the amount due

- Call us at 1-800-829-7650 to review your account with a representative. Be sure to have your account information available when you call.
- You can contact us by mail with the Contact information stub.

We'll assume you agree with the information in this notice if we don't hear from you.

## Payment options

### Pay now electronically

IRS Direct Pay is a free payment option to securely pay your tax bill directly from your checking or savings account. When you use Direct Pay, you can:

- Receive instant confirmation of your payment
- Schedule payments up to 30 days in advance
- Reschedule or cancel a payment before the due date
- Make a payment 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

We don't keep bank account information after we process your payment. To use Direct Pay, visit [www.irs.gov/directpay](http://www.irs.gov/directpay).

For a small fee, you can also pay by debit or credit card. To see all of our payment options, visit [www.irs.gov/payments](http://www.irs.gov/payments).

### Payment Plans

If you can't pay the full amount you owe, pay as much as you can now and make arrangements to pay your remaining balance. Visit [www.irs.gov/paymentplan](http://www.irs.gov/paymentplan) for more information on installment agreements and online payment agreements. You can also call us at 1-800-829-7650 to discuss your options.

An offer in compromise allows you to settle your tax debt for less than the full amount you owe. If we accept your offer, you can pay with either a lump sum cash payment plan or periodic payment plan. To see if you qualify, use the Offer in Compromise Pre-Qualifier tool at [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov), search term offer in compromise.

### Payment Information

To review payments we applied to your account, request a tax account transcript at [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov), search term "get transcript" or by calling 1-800-908-9946.

If you already paid your balance in full within the past 21 days or made payment arrangements, please disregard this notice. If you don't pay the amount due or call us to make payment arrangements, we will continue to send you annual reminder notices of your balance due until the statute of limitations for collection expires.

If you think we made a mistake, call 1-800-829-7650 to review your account.

## If we don't hear from you

If you don't pay \$147,334.65 by May 30, 2016, interest will increase and additional penalties may apply.

If a lien is already in place, you may find it difficult to sell or borrow against your property. The tax lien would also appear on your credit report — which may harm your credit rating.
