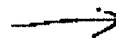

#### If you don't agree with the changes

Complete the Response form on Page 7, and send it to us along with a signed statement and any documentation that supports your claim so we receive it by June 29, 2017.

### If we don't hear from you

If we don't receive your response by June 29, 2017, we will send you a Statutory Notice of Deficiency which will allow you to dispute these changes in the U.S. Tax Court. If you choose not to petition the Tax Court, we will send you a final bill for the proposed amount due. During this time, interest will increase and penalties may apply.
