Reference is made to your 2015 New Jersey Gross Income Tax return.

You received a reduced refund of \$890.00. You did not claim your wages from your employer because you stated that you are an unprivileged worker in the private sector and as such your income should not be reported. Therefore you did not claim any of your income on the return, but you did claim the withholding that was made on your behalf and requested a full refund of that withholding. Under current New Jersey statutes, the income you received on your W-2s remains taxable and no further refund is due.

The above determination shall be final unless you apply to the Director of the Division of Taxation for a hearing within ninety (90) days. If you disagree with our findings and would like to apply for a hearing, please read and follow the enclosed Tax Appeal Process.
