Purpose of form This address is a substitute for forms W-2 or 1099-R and is completed by you or your representative when a your employer or payer has not issued you a Form W-2 or Form 1099-R or if an employer or payer has issued an incorrect form W-2 or Form 1099-R. Attach this form to the back of your income tax return with supporting forms or schedules.

You should attach this form to your Form W-2 or Form 1099-R from your employer or payer before contacting the IRS on this form. If you do not receive the missing form from your employer or payer by February 4, you should call the IRS at 800-829-1040 for assistance. You should provide your name, address, telephone number, Social Security number, and date of employment, and your employer's or payer's name, address, and ZIP code and identification number. The IRS will contact your employer or payer and request the missing form. If the IRS also will send you Form 1040-EZ, you should receive the missing form in sufficient time to file your income tax return. If you do not use the form 1040-EZ, you may use Form 1040.
