Mr. Bell,

I am in receipt of your letter dated Oct. 21, 2019 in which you request that I submit a form W-2, Wage and Tax Statement, among other items, "To support the amount of wage or withholding entry...".

First please note you have incorrectly addressed me as "Taxpayer" in the salutory statement of the referenced letter. This is in error and I request that you address me by my name.

Note that in my 1040 filing I included Form 4852, which states on the face of the form *Substitute for Form W-2, Wage and Tax Statement*. The inclusion of Form 4852 is validated by third party mailing affidavit so there is no doubt that it was part of the filing package.

The W-2 which you request is erroneous and the errors have been corrected in the Form 4852 which you received. I will not knowingly submit erroneous information in my 1040 filings so I am unable to accommodate your request.

It is my understanding that the information contained on a W-2 is provided to you by the Payer. If my assumption is incorrect and you wish to obtain the **erroneous information**, the Payer contact information is provided also on Form 4852.

Please immediately process my 2018 1040 filing with the correct information provided on Form 4852 which you have in your possession.
